 - Data Gathering and Analysis
 - McCoy will be available as a resource to Indy community to gather info on how to connect all of the resources available for youth
 - McCoy will compile all school, afterschool, other youth resources and make this available to the entire community as a sort of "Wikipedia". Responsibility for updating this info will fall to the agencies providing services
 - Building Community By-in for Youth Development
 - 60% of youth are not prepared at 21 for life/work/school
 - How can we build the buy-in to support these youth
 - o Program Quality Assessment
 - Program assessment tool by staff and external observes (by High Scope-<u>www.highscope.org</u> for more information on their main points for assessment and assessment theories)
 - Provides a framework to help agencies look at what they are doing and how they can do it better
 - Trained teams of all ages (youth-adult) will go in and comment on programs
 - Look at how to coordinate training in all local youth serving agencies
 - John and McCoy staff will be visiting sites around the country to gather information for implementation of the Indy Ready by 21 projects
 - John sees a partnership with ACI agencies as a tool to achieving the goals of the project
 - By being able to demonstrate progress/achievements, the afterschool movement will be able to better secure resources and support for programs- this is good advocacy
