- Congressional Visit for Afterschool May 13-14 in DC
 - Six people from Indiana attended
 - Judy talked about the discussions with the national legislators from Indiana about the afterschool network and briefings on afterschool funding
 - Jeanine Coleman and a student winner and their parent from IPS attended. The student won a contest in the IPS middle schools by writing an essay about why afterschool is important to them. The student and parent went with Jeanine to talk to the leaders. Jeanine attended a session about engaging high school students. One successful program in high school is debate.
 - David noted the importance of creating strong models for afterschool programs
 - Rep Donnelly was excited about afterschool he is a member of the afterschool caucus in the senate
 - It would be good for more from Indiana to attend- visit Afterschool Alliance .org website for more information on next years event.
- Boost Conference (Best Out of School Time Conference) Palm Springs
 - Shalom Black & Judy Frapps attended
 - Focused on afterschool and summer programs
 - Incorporated a lot of arts activities- there was a presentation by "Crew" middle and high school students
 - Presenter Jonathan Mooney- author with ADD and dyslexia overcame his disabilities
 - Session "do it yourself professional development"- ½ hour to 1 hour session templates
 - Session- "Securing a balanced and diversified funding base for your afterschool program" – finding stakeholders, building relationships and showing them the impact that your program makes (amount of jobs, amount of parents that can work, etc...)

- Andre Lewis author "I want to fly" will be visiting Indianapolis on June 19th (Judy will provide more info on his visit via email)
- Wide range of sessions on professional development, sustainability, etc...
- Herf Jones NYSTRO supplies for afterschool- globes, geography tools, etc.. Washington Twp. Will be using this to start an afterschool club about geography
- Center for Summer Learning Conference– John Hopkins Center for Summer Learning
 - Eric Williams & Mashariki Jywanza attended
 - o This organization will be working with Indianapolis programs this summer
 - Majority of sessions were about the games used to teach academics
 - Afterschool programs are playing a huge role in re-engaging kids
 - Energy Express- West Virginia ½ day program for 6 weeks with AmeriCorp creating a print rich environment. Program has improved students up 6 reading levels in 6 weeks
 - o Johns Hopkins is getting ready to offer a certificate in out of school learning
 - Need to have everyone (all stakeholders) at the table to build programs and create a "city plan"
 - Next year conference will be in Chicago
